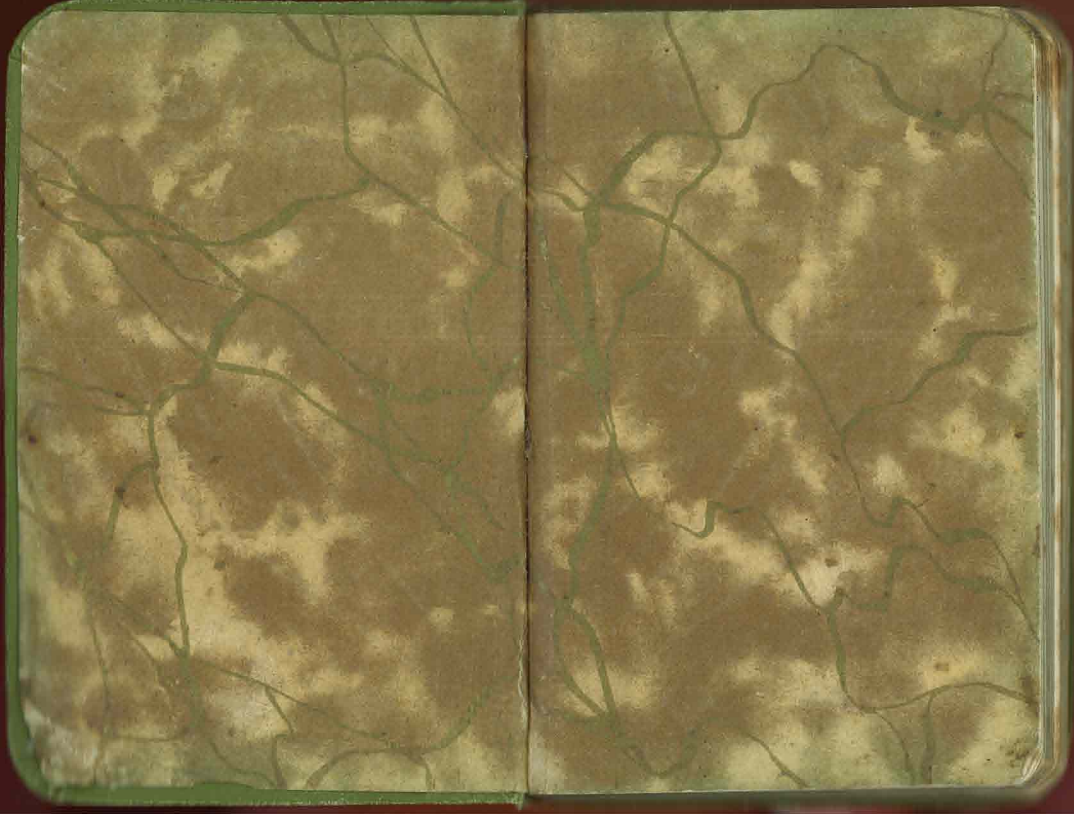

EXAMPLE.—On what day of the week will March 18th, 1918, fall? March 1st being Friday, 15th is also Friday, and 18th is Monday.

## ECLIPSES

(Greenwich Mean Times.)

1. January 20th.—A Partial Eclipse of the Moon, *partly visible* throughout the British Isles. The Moon enters the Earth's shadow at 7h. 55m. a.m., middle of Eclipse (mag. 0'137) at 8h. 40m. a.m. and Eclipse ends at 9h. 24m. a.m. At London the Moon sets at 8h. 5m. a.m.

2. February 3rd.—A Total Eclipse of the sun, *partly visible* throughout the British Isles as a Partial Eclipse. At London the Eclipse begins at 4h. 31m. p.m., the Sun setting at 4h. 49m. p.m.

3. July 15th.—A Partial Eclipse of the Moon, *partly visible* throughout the British Isles. The Moon enters the Earth's shadow at 3h. 19m. a.m., middle of Eclipse (mag. 0'800) at 4h. 46m. a.m. and Eclipse ends at 6h. 13m. a.m. At London the Moon sets at 3h. 56m. a.m.

4. July 30th.—An Annular Eclipse of the Sun, *invisible* throughout the British Isles.

5. December 24th.—A Partial Eclipse of the Sun, *invisible* throughout the British Isles. This is an extremely small Eclipse *visible* only in the South Indian and Atlantic Oceans.

## BANK HOLIDAYS.

England and Ireland.—Good Friday, April 21; Easter Monday, April 24; Whit Monday, June 12; Aug. 7; Christmas Day and Dec. 26; March 17 (Ireland only).

Scotland.—New Year's Day, January 1; Good Friday, April 21; May 1; August 7; and Christmas Day.
